

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Agreed by Trustees, 21/11/2016



As a charity whose purpose is to work with people to make big cuts in CO₂ emissions, we also aim to minimise all Cambridge Carbon Footprint's environmental impacts.

To achieve this we will:

- Consider how to minimise travel for CCF activities for staff, volunteers and participants; choose, recommend and facilitate lower-impact alternatives, like cycling and public transport, where practical; select venues with this in mind.
- Minimise electricity, heating and water use in our office and venues, as compatible with effectiveness and acceptable comfort.
- Choose low-impact equipment, supplies and catering from companies with a good environmental record, wherever practical.
- Identify and eliminate any toxic emissions or residues from CCF activities.
- Minimise waste. Maximise re-use and recycling. Use recycled products. eg: paper
- Meet or exceed all relevant environmental legislation.
- Advocate and promote these actions by others, including working with our landlord.

With appropriate consultation, we'll review how to improve our environmental performance and this policy at least annually, engaging staff and key volunteers in making the policy effective, with training, as necessary.
