

### Volunteer Opportunity: Outreach Stalls

We are frequently invited to host stalls at local events and festivals. Each one is an opportunity to talk to members of the public about CCF, carbon footprints and climate change. Stalls are more fun and successful if they are interactive, exciting and tailored to an event as closely as possible, which means always striving to innovate our approach.

Being on a stall means:

- Talking to members of the public one-to-one about CCF and climate change more generally.
- Helping participants with our carbon footprint calculator, carbon abacus game, and interactive kids' activities (we train you on how to deliver these).
- Being on-time, reliable, standing at a couple hours at a time, being able to get to different locations in Cambridge.

It needs someone who:

- Is outgoing and really comfortable talking to people.
- Is already somewhat familiar with concepts like a carbon footprint, climate change, etc.
- Likes the format of many short interactions within a short amount of time (kind of like networking).
- Can be on time and reliable. Most stall events are on weekends.
- Can complete the next available stalls training session.

Prefer working behind the scenes?

- We desperately need transport heroes who can help us get the display materials from the office to events around Cambridge and the surrounding villages (At the moment a car is vital with this, as well as superb punctuality and reliability).
- Help us innovate to make our stall more transportable by bicycle.
- Help design stall activities or create leaflets to hand out (for instance on our upcoming events).
- Find opportunities for us to hold stalls at local events and festivals
