As a charity whose purpose is to work with people to make big cuts in CO2 emissions, we also aim to minimise all Cambridge Carbon Footprint's environmental impacts.

To achieve this we will:

- Consider how to minimise travel for CCF activities for staff, volunteers and participants; choose, recommend and facilitate lower-impact alternatives, like cycling and public transport where practical; select venues with this in mind.
- Minimise electricity, heating and water use in our office and venues, as compatible with effectiveness and acceptable comfort.
- Choose low-impact equipment, supplies and catering from companies with a good environmental record, wherever practical.
- Identify and eliminate any toxic emissions or residues from CCF activities.
- Minimise waste. Maximise re-use and recycling. Use recycled products. eg: paper
- Meet or exceed all relevant environmental legislation.
- Advocate and promote these actions by others, including staff, volunteers and our landlord, offering training as necessary.
- Encourage staff and volunteers to be aware of their own personal environmental footprints.
- With appropriate consultation, regularly monitor our environmental footprint, set targets for improvement and create an action plan.
